Funding/ Policy Review Purpose

Title I funds

- Provide supplemental funding for resources to help schools provide a high quality education that will enable all children to meet performance standards in Math and ELA



Title I funds

- Funding is awarded based on economically disadvantaged students (poverty criteria), but any student enrolled may receive Title I services if they need additional support in Math or ELA



Summer Program

- Title I funds the summer program offered at Aura Elementary School
- The summer program promotes summer support for ELA, Math, Social-Emotional Learning, and Collaboration.
- The program is currently offered to currently enrolled students entering Kindergarten to 5th Grade



Additional Title I Expenses

- Summer Book and Math Game Exchange to help prevent summer learning regression
- Professional Development
- Intervention resources and materials
